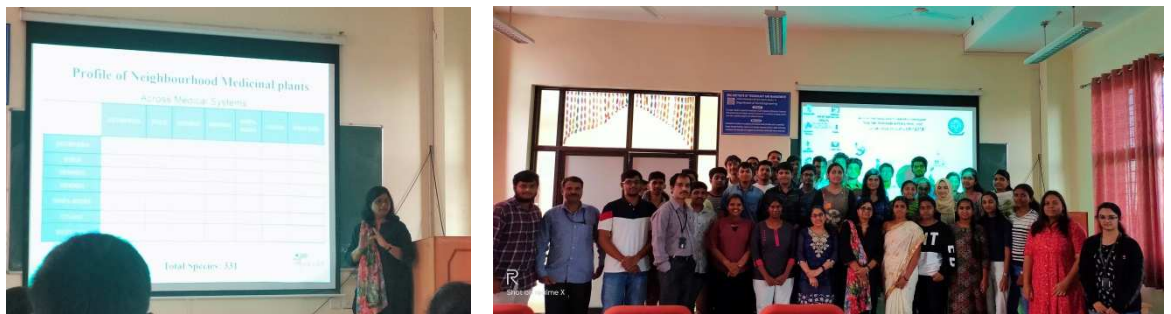

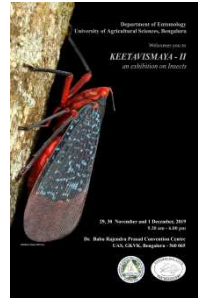

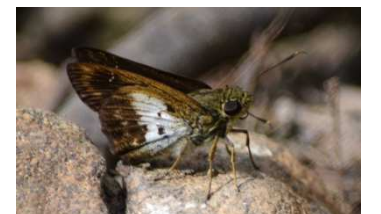

Further, Dr Rajesh Gopinath was one among the expert resource participant at the 1st official Butterfly Survey at Kali Tiger Reserve Forest, organized by Bangalore Butterfly Club and Jungle Lodges, in collaboration with Karnataka Forest Dept. Also, Dr Rajesh Gopinath was the team lead for the Annual Butterfly Survey at Shendurney Wildlife Sanctuary, Tenmala, Kerala on 29th December 2019. His team was posted at Idimuzhungum Mala, and has contributed to detecting 92 species of Butterflies including a new record of "*Sovia hyrtacus* (White-branded Ace)" from the region.

aranya_kfd Along with the Karnataka Forest Department and the Karnataka Eco Tourism Development Board, 20 members of the Bangalore Butterfly Club and 7 students from Sirsi college participated, in the Kali butterfly survey. About 4,500 individual butterflies were counted, belonging to 160 species.
